With the Libby app, Libraries Tasmania members can borrow and enjoy free eBooks, eAudiobooks, digital magazines and comics. from a collection of 18000+. All you need is an internet connection and your library card.



BorrowBox has thousands of eAudiobooks to listen to at any time, anywhere! Reserve or borrow up to 10 eAudiobooks at a time. Downloaded to your computer, tablet or mobile device using the BorrowBox app.



Story Box Library is a subscription based educational website, where you can view stories by local authors and illustrators, being read aloud by fantastic, predominantly Australian and New Zealand, storytellers.
